- Managing Intensive Outpatient (IOP) waitlists for the Eating Disorders IOP and Salem Adult IOP: assisting clients in obtaining medical clearance, communicating with outside providers to obtain medical records, orienting clients to the programs, scheduling appointments, assigning clients to individual therapists, and ensuring insurance authorizations are approved before client start dates
- Reviewing IOP client mental health assessments to determine risk level for suicide
- Facilitating IOP group therapy sessions in the Eating Disorders IOP, the adult IOPs, and teen IOP: providing validation and feedback on client homework practices, teaching DBT skills, leading mindfulness pracices, and assisting clients in setting effective goals
- Co-facilitating IOP group therapy sessions in the Eating Disorders IOP, the adult IOPs, and the teen IOP: providing one-on-one skills coaching to clients experiencing emotional dysregulation, nausea, and difficulty completing meals
- Attending weekly clinical supervision and weekly consultation team meetings
- Conducting internal and external research on DBT
- Updating clinic forms and the clinic website
- Co-managing an internship program for co-facilitators of Standard Program groups, communicating with interns and group leaders to schedule interns into groups and connecting them with individual supervisors
- Facilitating meal groups in Eating Disorders IOP: evaluating client meals to ensure that individual meal plan guidelines are met, coaching clients to add food to their meal when applicable, supporting clients in identifying hunger cues, providing individualized nutritional guidance for clients with a history of bariatric surgery, and facilitating effective and light-hearted conversation to maintain client regulation during meals
